



Minutes for May 12, 2026 Council Meeting

The Howardwick City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, May 12, 2026 at 6:00pm in City Hall with the Mayor, Mayor Pro-Tem, Council members, City Secretary and 13 guests.

1. Call to order: Mayor called meeting to order at 6:00pm
2. Invocation: Mayor Johnny Floyd gave the invocation
3. Pledge of allegiance: Everyone stood for the Pledge of allegiance
4. Approve bills due: Sandy noted a correction on bills due. Matt made a motion to approve bills. Jada seconded the motion. Vote taken. All approved with none opposed. Motion carried.
5. Foster & Lambert to present 2024-2025 Audit. Take action: April Ford with Foster & Lambert presented 24-25 Audit to the council and guests. Upon conclusion, there were no questions. Johnny Hubbard made a motion to approve the audit. Terry seconded the motion. Vote taken. All approved with none opposed. Motion carried.
6. Wes King from AmaTechTel to address the council. Take action if needed: Mr. King not present at this time. Moved to item #7
7. Approve minutes for April 14, 2026: Jada made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Matt seconded the motion. Vote taken. All approved with none opposed. Motion carried.
8. Mayors comments: Mayor Johnny Floyd updated everyone on events coming up and about raffle tickets available for Hoedown.
9. Citizens comments and/or Public comments on Agenda items: At this time any citizen who has filled out an appearance card prior to meeting will be heard in order that card was turned in and as time allows. All approved with none opposed. Motion carried.

11. Approve 21 TCG bid lots sold. Parcels 7723, 7757, 7772, 7774, 7776, 7778, 7947, 8424, 8480, 8482, 8508, 8517, 8577, 8610, 8669, 8671, 9224, 9260, 9262, 9245 and 9937. Take action: Sandy went over closed bid lots from last month. Johnny Hubbard made a motion to approve all TCG bid lots. Jada seconded the motion. Vote taken. All approved with none opposed. Motion carried.


