



## Minutes for February 10, 2026 Council Meeting


The Howardwick City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, May 13, 2025 at 6:00pm in City Hall with the Mayor, Mayor Pro-Tem, Council members, City Secretary and 8 guests.

1. Call to order: Mayor called meeting to order at 6:00pm
2. Invocation: Johnny Floyd gave the invocation
3. Pledge of allegiance: Everyone stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Mayors comments: Mayor cautioned everyone that Ama TechTel still digging for fiber optics and water may be an issue for about a month.
5. Council to approve minutes for January 13, 2026: Jada made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Matt seconded the motion. Vote taken. All approved with none opposed. Motion carried.
6. Approve bills due: After review and a question about Foster and Lambert, Terry made a motion to pay the bills. Johnny Hubbard seconded the motion. Vote taken. All approved with none opposed. Motion carried.
7. Citizens comments and/or Public comments on Agenda items: At this time any citizen who has filled out an appearance card prior to meeting will be heard in order that card was turned in and as time allows. Each person will have 3 minutes. In accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, the City Council may not deliberate or vote on any matter raised regarding Citizens comments. In order to complete City Business this portion of the meeting will be limited to 15 minutes.: With no comments turned in, moved to item #8.
8. Council to consider donation for Donley County Senior Citizens. Take action: Council discussed if a donation was to be made and the amount of past donations. Jada made a motion to donate \$2,000.00. Motion died due to a lack of a second. Matt made a motion to donate \$1,500.00. Mary seconded the motion. Vote taken. All approved with none opposed. Motion carried.

9. Council to approve order of election for May 2, 2026. Take action: Sandy presented Order of election for 3 Alderman seats. The 3 incumbents are the only ones singed up at this time and Friday is the deadline. If no-one else applies, election can be cancelled. Terry made a motion to approve the Order of Election and to cancel if no-one else applies. Jada seconded the motion. Vote taken. All approved with none opposed. Motion carried.  
10. Adjourn: With no further business, meeting was adjourned.
